- Urban roads: 30 - 50 km/h

PALACIO DE VILLAPANÉS, SEVILLE

You join us for the start of our journey in the Lexus LC Convertible and Coupe at the Palacio de Villapanés in the historic heart of Seville. Our sunset reception on the roof terrace gives us an exceptional panorama view of the city's famous landmarks, including the Giralda tower and Gothic cathedral. The Palacio is one of Seville's best-preserved examples of Baroque architecture, built around 1729 as a residence for Admiral López Pintado, a key figure in the history of Andalucía. It remained the property of the Marquesses of Villapanés until the early 21st century when it was sensitively converted into a luxury hotel, opening its doors in 2009. The transformation has protected the building's superb architectural features and it has been officially recognised as one of Seville's great cultural assets. The interior offers hidden treasures and features, including a series of courtyards where you can relax among fountains, palms and banana trees.



HACIENDA EL ROSALEJO, VILLAMARTÍN

The first stop on our test drive is the Hacienda El Rosalejo, one of the most important properties belonging to the Dukes of Ahumada. Set in the foothills of the Sierra de Cádiz, it has witnessed key moments in Spanish history since the 18th century. The original building was almost destroyed during the Napoleonic Wars, but later it became a favourite recreational residence for the aristocratic Ahumada family. In 1845, the second duke wrote the Cartilla del Guardia Civil at El Rosalejo, the document which founded Spain's national police force. Today, the house remains the property of the Ahumada family but welcomes guests for events, celebrations and fine dining in its unique and beautiful surroundings.

LA ORGANIC EXPERIENCE, RONDA

Our lunch venue is the LA Organic Experience in the famous mountain-top town of Ronda. LA Organic is a modern, eco-focused business that draws on the finest traditions of olive oil production. This began locally around 200 years ago with a community of nuns who started making oil from a grove of centuries-old trees. This grove, LA Amarilla, now belongs to the Gómez de Baeza family, who founded LA Organic in the 1990s. As well as its high-quality products, LA Organic is creating the LA Organic Experience to reveal to visitors the history, production processes and special qualities of its oils. This “oleotourism” centre is housed in a unique setting created by the internationally renowned architect and designer Philippe Starck.



THE MARBELLA CLUB, MARBELLA

Final destination on our drive through Andalucía is the world-famous Marbella Club. Originally a humble hide-away for the von Hohenlohe family – the Finca Santa Margerita – it has grown to become one of the finest luxury locations in Spain. Founded by Prince Max in 1946, it became an exclusive centre for the international jet-set in the 1950s, under the guidance of his son, Prince Alfonso. In 1954 there were just 20 rooms, but by attracting the world’s most famous names to Marbella, it helped make this part of Spain a rival to the best resorts on France’s Côte d’Azur. Today the Marbella Club is a member of Relais & Châteaux and The Leading Hotels of the World, offering its guests first class facilities and services, including villas designed with welcoming home-from-home décor and a Thalasso wellness spa.
